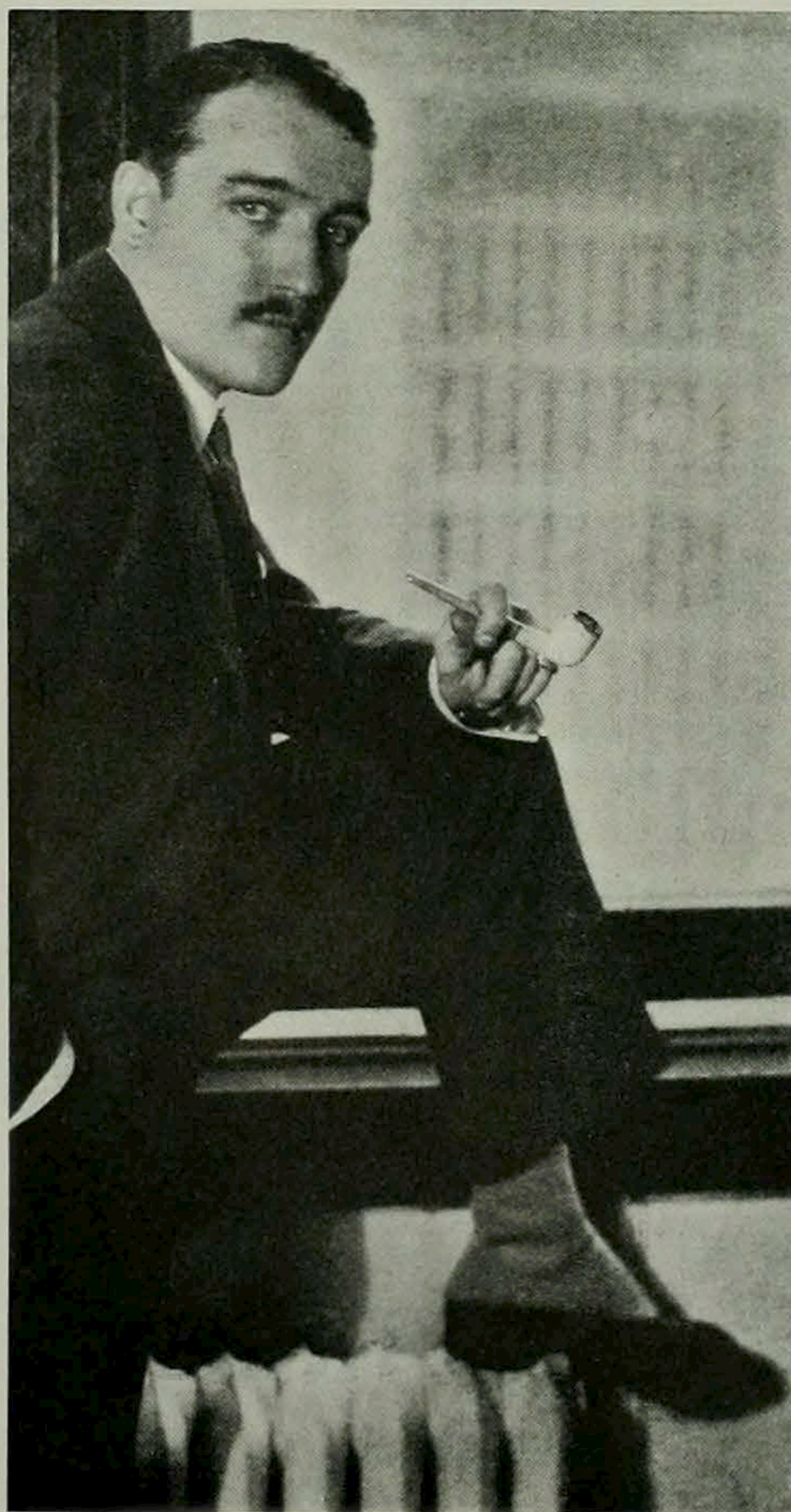


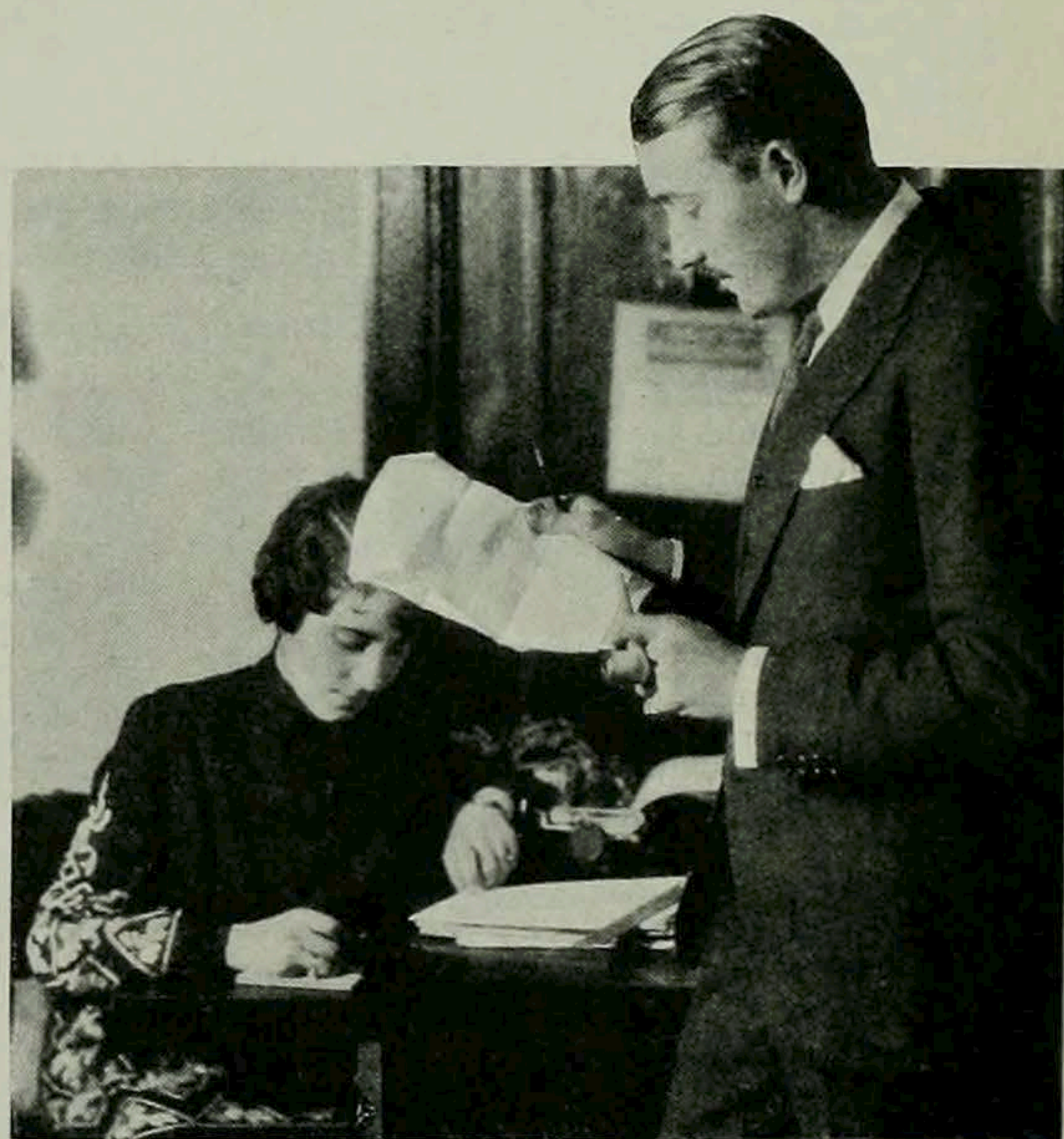
He's in Conference . . .
